



EXPRESSION OF INTEREST FOR THE SUPPLY AND ERECTION OF ANTI-CLIMB CLEAR VIEW FENCE

The Bank of Botswana seeks submissions of Expressions of Interest (EOI) to prequalify from well-established, locally based and accredited specialist contractors in the fencing industry for the supply and erection of anti-climb clear view fence and gates to various Staff houses at the Bank's housing estate in Gaborone West Phase 1.

The fencing products should meet the following physical characteristics:

- Anti-climb
- Anti-cut
- Spikes
- Anti-tamper fixators
- Transparent see through panels
- Welded and UV resistant polymer powder coated to galvanised mesh and components

This call for expressions of interest and pre-qualification is intended to identify suppliers with the capacity to supply such security fence systems. In order to prequalify to be invited to tender, all companies responding to this call for expression of interest must submit documentation as requested below, which will be used to derive a short-list of companies to invite to tender:

- List of equivalent completed projects together with at least three written references and/or details of contactable referees (Clients).
- A brief company profile confirming in concise form, the structure of the company and holding companies (where applicable), date of establishment, ownership, base of operations, specialisations, accreditations, honours and awards, infrastructural resources in Botswana and/or elsewhere, experience and other relevant data.
- Tenderers are also required to submit relevant copy of Licences or Public Procurement and Assets Disposal Board (PPADB) certificate.
- Status of ISO 9001, ISO 14001 and OHSAS 18001 certification.
- A short statement from your bank or financiers demonstrating the financial capacity of the company.
- A short statement about any litigation the company may be involved in currently or have been involved in during the past five years if any.
- An outline of management expertise and resources available within the firm.
- For a joint venture; state the nature of the JV arrangement, and provide information requested above for all constituent companies.
- Bidders must commit to compliance with the Botswana Citizen Economic Empowerment Policy current at the time of tender.

- It is a requirement that the taxes of the participating bidders **must** be in good standing or that suitable payment agreement will have been agreed with the tax authorities. Tenderers are therefore, requested to obtain and submit a copy of a tax clearance certificate or letter from the tax authorities.

Contractors are urged to keep submissions concise and submissions should not exceed 15 A4 size pages in length per company.

The Bank will evaluate the submissions and short-list suppliers to be invited to tender. The Bank is not restricted to considering only those who directly respond to this advertisement and reserves the right to invite other known entities for the full tender.

The Bank of Botswana supports “Domestic Preference” procurement policy.

Interested parties are required to pay a non-refundable fee of P350, inclusive of VAT, and submit their expressions of interest in writing. Include a copy of your payment receipt in the submission.
